Drawing & Painting: Level 2b

Learners will engage in both personal and collaborative projects, supporting creative growth and skill development.

This is a drawing and painting course level 2B, upon completing this course, learners can progress onto Level 2C Painting and Drawing class but cannot redo this course at the same level or book onto lower-level courses (such as Drawing & Painting 1A, 1B or 1C). Learners can book onto any other Art specialism or Creative & Culture courses from 1A upwards.

What Will I Learn On This Course?

By the end of the course, learners will be able to:

1. Use at least two drawing materials such as pencil, graphite, charcoal, or pen & ink to build confidence and skill through careful observation and accurate rendering.

2. Work with a minimum of two painting materials, including watercolours, acrylics, or soft pastels, to explore different approaches to painting.

3. Apply at least two painting techniques, such as Impressionism, Expressionism, or Realism, to create original pieces of artwork.

Whether you would like to learn new creative skills or to investigate the possibility of a new art -based career, MAE Community Learning courses can provide you with a stepping stone to progress

Is This Course Suitable For Me?

This course is suitable for individuals with foundational skills or extended experience in Art and Design. This is not a beginner's course.
