This is a level 1a art specialism course for beginners in this subject area or those who have completed Drawing & Painting 2C.

Under the guidance of our expert tutor, you will engage with the foundational skills starting with how to draw and layout letters by hand and then learning the brush techniques needed to create beautiful signs. Working by hand, participants not only hone their artistic abilities but also honour a legacy of craftsmanship, thus contributing to the resurgence of these time-honoured skills in a world increasingly dominated by technology. This hands-on approach cultivates not only creativity but also an appreciation for the process and the value of authentic craftsmanship.

WHAT WILL I LEARN ON THIS COURSE?

1. Demonstrate an understanding of at least 2 principles underpinning letter form and spacing
2. Demonstrate an understanding of at least 2 brushwork techniques to create traditional lettering styles using a Mahl stick
3. Demonstrate free hand lettering on at least 3 different letters or numbers

The tutor will work with you as an individual to set personal goals alongside the group learning aims.

IS THIS COURSE SUITABLE FOR ME?

Surface preparation

Use of a Mahl stick to create smooth brush strokes
Care of paint brushes
