WHAT WILL I LEARN ON THIS COURSE?

By the end of the course, learners will be able to:

1. Use at least two drawing materials to build confidence in still life drawing
2. Work with at least two painting or pastel mediums to explore technique
3. Apply at least two painting techniques to create original pieces of artwork.
