WHAT WILL I LEARN ON THIS COURSE?

By the end of the course, learners will:

1. Create at least two drawings using different materials (such as pencil, charcoal, or ink)
 2. Create at least two paintings using different media (such as watercolour, acrylic, or pastel)
 3. Explore at least two art styles (e.g. Impressionism, Expressionism, Realism) and use them in your own work
- You will also use skills like proportion, line, colour mixing, and composition to produce your own original artwork. Whether you would like to learn new creative skills or to investigate the possibility of a new art-based career, MAE Community Learning courses can provide you with a stepping stone to progress.

IS THIS COURSE SUITABLE FOR ME?

This course is aimed at learners who:

- Already have basic or intermediate art skills
- Have done a drawing/painting course at level 1A – 2B or have similar experience

IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THIS COURSE?

This course is mainly practical, but some sessions will include important theory and professional topics. These may include:
